

Watercolor Challenge Materials List

PAINTS: Tubes of watercolor – good brands are Holbein or artist's quality Winsor & Newton Recommended colors (but bring what you have – pans are also ok to use):

I rely heavily on transparency, so I recommend Aureolin, Rose madder, (or Permanent Rose) and Cobalt Blue. If you're on a budget try to have these three plus Payne's Gray.

·Lemon Yellow ·Cadmium Yellow ·Raw Sienna ·Cadmium Red ·Alizarin Crimson ·Cerulean Blue ·French Ultramarine ·Viridian Green ·Burnt Sienna ·Payne's Gray (mentioned above)

BRUSHES: Sable or sable/synthetic mix brushes (bring what you have)

·#6 or #8 round ·#12 or #14 round ·A squirrel hair brush or any wash brush.

PAPER:

Blocks or pads – Arches pads are recommended (9" x 12" or 12" x 16") or you can tear from full sheets – 140 lb Cold Press paper, 22" x 30". I prefer Hot Press, but it's not recommended for beginners.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS: ·A plastic palette with a lid ·a container for water

·Paper towel
