

## Watercolor Batik with Erica Qualey

### Materials List:

Paint - This list is a good foundation of colors to start a pallet. If you already own watercolor paints please just use what you have, but remember that it is important to have both a warm and cool hue for each color group.

Cobalt Blue  
Ultramarine Blue  
Cadmium Red  
Burnt Sienna  
Viridian Green  
Sap Green  
Lemon Yellow  
Yellow Ochre  
Neutral Tint

A white plastic rectangular pallet with a cover is suitable. It is important that it is large enough to have plenty of mixing space and deep wells to hold paint.

Brushes -

At least one round brush with a nice point (something on the larger side, like a 10).

A larger flat or mop brush for wetting and laying down washes.

One round inexpensive but still pointed brush to use applying wax. This brush will not be usable with paint again.

Miscellaneous - A black waterproof pen (Micron pens are my favorite), pencil, kneaded eraser, sketchbook, water container, hairdryer, a stack of old newspapers, iron, 1 piece of black construction paper, parchment paper (the kind you cook with), and paraffin wax.
