

Supply List - The Basics: Intro to Oil Painting with Douglas Smith

Paper palette pad for mixing oil paints is ideal.

Palette knife.

Bring a small metal oil cup, the type that clips on to a palette, or bring a small glass jar with a lid. To limit the odor of paint thinner, the instructor will supply odorless thinner.

A paper or plastic bag to take home any clean-up paper towels or cloth rags after each class.

Brushes: an inexpensive variety pack will suffice.

Paints:

If you already have oil painting supplies, bring what you have.

Basic color list:

Titanium White,

Alizarin Crimson,

Cadmium Yellow Light,

Cadmium Orange,

Ultramarine Blue.

The student grade of these brands would be great: Winton, Rowney, Blick Studio Color

Canvas panels, no larger than 11 x 14 inches
